## **NEW ITEMS:**

### **Draft §363(b) Sale Guidelines**

The court is seeking comments on proposed LBF 363, Guidelines Regarding Motions for Sales of All or Substantially All Assets and Sale Procedures Motions. ### **ECF Training**

## **PREVIOUSLY PUBLISHED ITEMS:**

The following is a summary of items added in the past several weeks.

### **Bankruptcy Judgeship Vacancy**

The US Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada, Reno, has an opening for a bankruptcy judge. The position is available on January 1, 2011, and completed application materials are due by 5 pm on Wednesday, March 31, 2010. ### **ECF Waiver**

The court has approved a limited waiver of the ECF filing requirements for lawyers whose only work in bankruptcy court is on a pro bono basis for chapter 7 debtors. The waiver application and order forms are posted on the Debtor-Creditor section website at <http://osb-dc.org/bankruptcyclinic.htm>.

### **Local Bankruptcy Rules**

New Local Bankruptcy Rules are now in effect. The court has posted the updated LBRs on the website in clean and redline/strikeout versions. Both versions begin with a summary of changes from the previous set of adopted local rules. Click on **Rules and Forms** on the top bar, then on "Local Bankruptcy Rules," to access both versions.

Under the new rules, filers are required to file reaffirmation agreements using Official Form #B240A. The court has discontinued LBF #718.5 as of January 1, 2010.

### **Local Rules Committee**

The Debtor-Creditor Section has reestablished a Local Rules Committee to review and discuss new local rules and forms on an ongoing basis. ### **Local Forms**

Exhibit D has been updated and a new Official Form B27 replaces LBF 718.05. Click on **Rules and Forms** on the top bar, then on "Official National Bankruptcy Forms (e.g., Petition & Schedule) (OBF)," to go to the US Courts Bankruptcy Forms page, then click on Part I to find Exhibit D and form B27.
